Present Continuous Tense

• To talk about something that is happening now, at exactly this moment.

• Often used with time words and prahses like *now, right now,* and *at the moment.*

| Positive | <u>S + to be + Ving + C</u> | |
|--------------|---|--|
| | He is helping a customer to open a new savings account. I am cooking fried rice for our breakfast right now. They are learning English at the moment. | |
| Negative | <u>S + To be + not + Ving + C</u> | |
| | He <i>is not helping</i> a customer to open a new savings account. I <i>am not cooking</i> fried rice for our breakfast right now. They are not learning English at the moment. | |
| Interogative | <u>To be + S + Ving + C?</u> | |
| | Is he helping a customer to open a new savings account. Am I cooking fired rice for our breakfast right now? Are they learning English at the moment? | |
| | Negative | |


SIMPLE PRESENT VS PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE






Georg (serve customers bank / watch a football match)


Example: a) Every day Georg serves customers in a bank.b) Right now he is watching a football match.
